ORDINANCE #1589

Tax Abatement – 304-306 Main Street

ORDINANCE GRANTING TAX ABATEMENT PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:21-1, ET SEQ., "FIVE YEAR EXEMPTION AND ABATEMENT LAW" TO PAR REALTY, LLC FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION ON 304-306 MAIN STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF KEANSBURG.





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WHEREAS, the Borough of Keansburg ("Borough") may enter into agreements with developers and/or owners of property that are in areas in need of redevelopment or rehabilitation within the Borough, as determined by the Council in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et seq. providing tax abatements and/or exemptions for the construction of commercial or industrial structures within the Borough pursuant to the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined that it is in the best long term interest of the Borough to grant a short term tax abatement and enact this Ordinance to allow Par Realty, LLC to obtain a program for payments in lieu of taxes; and

WHEREAS, Par Realty, LLC has completed new construction on a mixed-use building for commercial and residential use on 304-306 Main Street, which the Borough believes will attract additional residents to live and work in the Borough and such benefits are greater to the Borough than any short term effects associated with the proposed tax abatement, if any.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keansburg, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. That Par Realty, LLC shall be granted a short-term, five (5) year abatement for Block 185, Lot 1 and shall be structured as follows:
 - a. In the first full tax year after completion of the Construction, no payment in lieu of taxes shall be required;
 - b. In the second full tax year after completion of the Construction, twenty percent (20%) of taxes otherwise due shall be paid by Par Realty, LLC;
 - c. In the third full tax year after completion of the Construction, forty percent (40%) of taxes otherwise due shall be paid by Par Realty, LLC;
 - d. In the fourth full tax year after completion of the Construction, sixty percent (60%) of taxes otherwise due shall be paid by Par Realty, LLC;
 - e. In the fifth full tax year after completion of the Construction, eighty percent (80%) of taxes otherwise due shall be paid by Par Realty, LLC;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keansburg being the same is hereby authorized to execute a five (5) year tax abatement which is to be consistent with the terms of this Ordinance as certified by the Borough Attorney for the Borough of Keansburg and as reviewed by the Tax Assessor of the Borough of Keansburg.







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BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that his Ordinance shall take effect immediately after the final passage and publication as required by law.

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ORDINANCE #1590

Planning Board Fees

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 22 (DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS) SECTION 3.14 (PLANNING BOARD; FEES) OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF KEANSBURG (Refundable Application Escrow Fees)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keansburg as follows: Section 1:Chapter XXII (Development Regulations), Section 3.14 (Planning Board; Fees) shall read:

I. Refundable Application Escrow Fees.

The fees required by this subsection shall be for the purpose of reimbursing the Borough for direct fees, costs, charges and expenses of an extraordinary nature made by the professional consultants retained by or on behalf of the Borough and/or its boards, commissions or agencies in reviewing, testifying and/or assisting the Borough in the evaluation, planning and proper design of municipal services and facilities necessary to accommodate the present or anticipated needs of a proposed development. Said refundable application escrow fee shall be calculated at three (3) times the total application fee.

Section 2: REPEALER. The remainder of all other sections and subsections of the aforementioned ordinance not specifically amended by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES. All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to such inconsistency.

Section 4: SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 5: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

WHEREAS, N.J.S. 40A:4-19 provides that where any contract, commitment or payments are to be made prior to the final adoption of the CY 2017 budget, temporary appropriations should be made for the purpose and amounts required in the manner and time therein provided; and

WHEREAS, the effective date of this Resolution shall be JANUARY 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the total appropriations in the CY 2016 budget, exclusive of any appropriations made for interest and debt redemption charges, capital improvement fund and public assistance in the sum of:

CY 2016 Municipal Budget \$ 17,180,927.07

CY 2016 Water Sewer Utility Budget \$ 3,263,000.00

WHEREAS, 26.25% of the total appropriations in the CY 2016 budget, exclusive of any appropriations made for interest and debt redemption charges, capital improvement fund and public assistance in said CY 2017 budget is the sum of:

CY 2017 Municipal Budget \$ 4,509,993.35
