WHEREAS, the Borough Attorney reviewed the Askari Consruction Inc. bid documents, which failed to include the price form, and thus cannot be considered due to this material issue; and

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by Tekcon Construction, Inc. was the lowest dollar amount received totaling four-hundred eight thousand four hundred fifty dollars (\$408,450.00); and

WHEREAS, the Tekcon Construction, Inc. bid documents have been reviewed by the Borough Attorney and has found same to be in satisfactory legal format.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Keansburg, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey that it does hereby award the bid for the Façade Alterations to Various Buildings in the Borough of Keansburg to **Tekcon Construction, Inc.**, 262 Bennetts Lane, Somerset, New Jersey 08873 in accordance with the bid specifications for three-hundred seventy-five thousand one hundred fifty dollars (\$375,150.00) specifically and expressly contingent upon the mutually satisfactory resolution of any submitted bid exceptions.
