### **Community Development Block Grant Hearing**

At this time a presentation was made for improvements to the Beaconlight Drainage System. The improvements would include replacement of the drainage lines on Beaconlight and Twilight Avenues from Birchwood Avenue to Park Avenue. Additionally, there would be repairs to the roadway and upgrade of intersections, including sidewalks, to comply with ADA regulations. The Project is in the area eligible for consideration by the Monmouth County Community Development Block Grant Committee. The Beaconlight drainage system is the largest outfall system in the Borough. It is hopeful that these upgrades would alleviate flooding in that area as well as the adjacent neighborhood.

Mr. Cusick reported that the Citizen Participation meeting was held earlier this evening and the Committee endorsed the Project for consideration. The Borough Council is receptive to this project as these neighborhoods experience severe flooding and has been severely impacted by the storm surge created by Superstorm Sandy.

A written requisition for the performance of such work or labor, or the furnishing of materials, supplies or services is filed with the contracting agent or his deputy in charge describing the nature of the emergency, the time of its occurrence and the need for invoking this section, certified by the officer or director in charge of the department wherein the emergency occurred, or such other officer or employee as may be authorized to act in the place of said officer or director, and the contracting agent or his deputy in charge, being satisfied that the emergency exists, is hereby authorized to award a contract for said work or labor, materials, supplies or services; and

**WHEREAS**, an emergency situation meeting the criteria set forth above resulting from an **EMERGENCY REPAIR OF Well #5**.

WHEREAS, an emergency purchase/repair was made by Layne Christensen Company, Dallas, Texas in the amount not to exceed of \$ 40,000.00 for said water main repairs

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:5-4 requires the governing body of every local unit to have made an annual audit of its books, accounts and financial transactions, and

WHEREAS, the Annual Report of Audit for the year CY2016 has been filed by a Registered Municipal Accountant with the Municipal Clerk pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:5-6, and a copy has been received by each member of the governing body; and,

**WHEREAS**, R.S. 52:27BB-34 authorizes the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey to prescribe reports pertaining to the local fiscal affairs; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Local Finance Board has promulgated N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5, a regulation requiring that the governing body of each municipality shall by resolution certify to the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey that all members of the governing body have reviewed, as a minimum, the sections of the annual audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations, and,

**WHEREAS**, the members of the governing body have personally reviewed as a minimum the Annual Report of Audit, and specifically the sections of the Annual Audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations, as evidenced by the group affidavit form of the governing body attached hereto; and,

**WHEREAS**, such resolution of certification shall be adopted by the Governing Body no later than forty-five days after the receipt of the annual audit, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5; and,

WHEREAS, all members of the governing body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board, and

**WHEREAS**, failure to comply with the regulations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the local governing body to the penalty provisions of R.S. 52:27BB-52, to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52: A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, That the Borough Council of the Borough of Keansburg, County of Monmouth, hereby states that it has complied with N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5 and does hereby submit a certified copy of this resolution and the required affidavit to said Board to show evidence of said compliance.
