If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 5: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law and approval by the Department of Transportation.
