ORDINANCE #1586

CAPITAL ORDINANCE – Various Capital Improvements

CAPITAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, BY AND IN THE BOROUGH OF KEANSBURG, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING \$500,000 THEREFORE FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO PAY FOR THE COST THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Borough of Keansburg, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey (the "Borough"), wishes to undertake various general capital improvements throughout the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the cost of said improvements or purposes is estimated to be \$500,000; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has available and desires to authorize the appropriation and expenditure of \$500,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough, to undertake various general capital improvements including, but not limited to, acquisition and installation, as applicable, of various equipment, building improvements, roadway improvements, park improvements or any other improvement to any Borough facility, Borough property or causing a public benefit to the Borough and at various locations throughout the Borough.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF KEANSBURG, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY (a majority of the full membership thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:



SECTION 1. The capital improvement or purpose described below is hereby authorized as a general capital improvement to be undertaken by the Borough. For the said improvement or purpose, there is hereby appropriated the amount of \$500,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough, to undertake various general capital improvements including, but not limited to, acquisition and installation, as applicable, of various equipment, building improvements, roadway improvements, park improvements or any other improvement to any Borough facility, Borough property or causing a public benefit to the Borough and at various locations throughout the Borough. Such improvements shall include, as applicable, surveying, engineering and design work, construction planning, preparation of plans and specifications, permits, bid documents, construction inspection and contract administration, and all work, materials, equipment, labor and appurtenances necessary therefore or incidental thereto as described in Section 2.

SECTION 2. The expenditure of the \$500,000 consisting of the appropriation of \$500,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough, for the improvement or purpose set forth in Section 1 hereof is hereby authorized and approved. All expenditures for such improvement or purpose shall comply with the Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et. seq. and all plans, specifications or purchase orders therefor on file with or through the Borough Clerk, as finally approved by the governing body of the Borough.

SECTION 3. The 2016 capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and a resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital programs as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs is on file in the Office of the Clerk and is available for public inspection.

SECTION 4. An aggregate amount not exceeding \$500,000 for interest on said obligations, costs of issuing said obligations, engineering costs, legal fees and other items of expense listed in and permitted under N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20 is included as part of the cost of said improvements and is included in the estimated cost indicated herein for said improvements.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after final adoption and approval by the Mayor as described in N.J.S.A. 40:49-2.

ORDINANCE #1587 Acquisition of Property (17 Frances Place)

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF KEANSBURG TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AND DESIGNATED BLOCK 94, LOT 47 ON THE BOROUGH OF KEANSBURG TAX MAP

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keansburg find that it is the best interests of the Borough to acquire 17 Frances Place for use to expand Friendship Park; and WHEREAS, the Borough of Keansburg wishes to acquire in fee certain real property located on 17 Frances Place, which is known and designed as Block 94, Lot 47 on the Keansburg Borough Tax Map (record owner: Mildred Mullachuck Schacht); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keansburg believe that the acquisition of this property in fee, pursuant to the "Local Lands and Buildings Law," N.J.S.A. 40a:12-1, et seq., will greatly benefit the residents of the Borough; and



WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keansburg adopted Bond Ordinance No. 1568 to appropriate the sum of \$70,000, including \$19,000 grant funds derived from the County of Monmouth Municipal Open Space Grand Fund, for said purchase of 17 Frances Place.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keansburg, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. That, pursuant to the "Local Lands and Buildings Law," N.J.S.A. 40a:12-1, et seq., the Borough of Keansburg is hereby authorized to acquire in fee the real property known and designated as Block 94, Lot 47 on the Keansburg Borough Tax Map for use to expand Friendship Park.
- 2. That the expenditure of funds for the said acquisition, including all related costs, in an amount not to exceed \$70,000, is hereby authorized, and said funds are available via Bond Ordinance No. 1568 to appropriate the sum of \$70,000, including \$19,000 grant funds derived from the County of Monmouth Municipal Open Space Grand Fund.
- 3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and the Borough Clerk to attest any and all documents that are necessary in order to effectuate the acquisition of this property, including Assignment Agreements, provided that said documents are in a form acceptable to the Borough Attorney prior to final execution.
- 4. That all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- 5. That his Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
- 6. That, in the event that any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be limited in its effect only to that portion of the Ordinance actually adjudge to be invalid, and the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall not be affected.
- 7. That this Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.

Acquisition of Property (Main Street Lot, adjacent to Beachway)

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF KEANSBURG TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AND DESIGNATED BLOCK 22, LOT 6 ON THE BOROUGH OF KEANSBURG TAX MAP

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keansburg find that it is the best interests of the Borough to acquire property adjacent to the Baywalk; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Keansburg wishes to acquire in fee certain real property, which is known and designed as Block 22, Lot 6 on the Keansburg Borough Tax Map (record owner: Joseph Galbierczyk); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keansburg believe that the acquisition of this property in fee, pursuant to the "Local Lands and Buildings Law," N.J.S.A. 40a:12-1, et seq., will greatly benefit the residents of the Borough; and



WHEREAS, the Borough has the requisite funding to purchase Block 22, Lot 6 via the Recreation Trust Account entitled "Recreation – Omni Lease Payments – St. Johns Tower #T-15-56-806-299."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keansburg, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. That, pursuant to the "Local Lands and Buildings Law," N.J.S.A. 40a:12-1, et seq., the Borough of Keansburg is hereby authorized to acquire in fee the real property known and designated as Block 22, Lot 6 on the Keansburg Borough Tax Map.
- 2. That the expenditure of funds for the said acquisition, including all related costs, in an amount not to exceed \$22,000, is hereby authorized, and said funding is available via the Recreation Trust Account entitled "Recreation Omni Lease Payments St. Johns Tower #T-15-56-806-299."
- 3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and the Borough Clerk to attest any and all documents that are necessary in order to effectuate the acquisition of this property, including Assignment Agreements, provided that said documents are in a form acceptable to the Borough Attorney prior to final execution.
- 4. That all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- 5. That his Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
- 6. That, in the event that any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be limited in its effect only to that portion of the Ordinance actually adjudge to be invalid, and the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall not be affected.
