ORDINANCE #1647 Bed and Breakfast Ordinance

An Ordinance Amending and Supplementing an Ordinance entitled Motels, Hotels, Tourist Lodges, Motor Lodges, Motor Courts, Tourist Courts or Bed and Breakfast Establishments.

Section 1:

- 3-13.4 Duty of Police Department and Authorized Agent. Shall be DELETED in its entirety. And replaced by:
 - 3-13.4 Duty of the Borough Manager or his designee.

It shall be the duty of the Borough Manager or his designee to inspect the premises from time-to time, at any hour of the day or night, to determine that the provisions of this section are complied with.

3-13.3 Register to be maintained; Regulations.

- 3. Pay a registration fee to the Borough of Keansburg in the annual amount of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00).
- 4. Before receiving the annual license from the Borough there shall be an annual inspection to assure carbon dioxide detectors and fire extinguishers and in working order on the premises.
- 5. Other safety items as designated by the Borough Manager or his designee that go to the safety and wellbeing of the transient guests shall be complied with prior to the annual license being issued.
- 6. Each bed and Breakfast shall have at least one dwelling unit occupied by the owner of the facility or his agent as his place of residence during any time that the facility is being used for the lodging of guests or the owner or agent of the owner shall be within 15 minutes travel distance of the facility while the guests are lodging there. The owner or agent shall carry out the applicable duties described in this chapter. If the owner or agent is not on site, there shall be a clearly legible sign, conspicuously displayed in the area where the guests register, containing the owner's or agent's name, address (including unit number or apartment number) and a 24-hour emergency telephone number.
- Section 2: All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- Section 3: Should any section, paragraph clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

ORDINANCE #1648 Ordinance #1604 (Well #5- Retitle)

BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING IN PART BOND ORDINANCE NO. 1604 ADOPTED JANUARY 17, 2018, PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGN AND REPLACEMENT OF WELL #5, AND APPROPRIATING \$895,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$850,250 BONDS AND NOTES TO FINANCE A PORTION OF THE COSTS THEREOF, IN ORDER TO EXPAND THE SCOPE OF IMPROVEMENTS TO INCLUDE THE SEABREEZE WAY WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROGRAM, AUTHORIZED IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF KEANSBURG, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Borough of Keansburg, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Borough") adopted Bond Ordinance No. 1604 on January 17, 2018 (the "Prior Ordinance") authorizing the design and replacement of Well #5; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined that the purpose should be amended to include the Seabreeze Way Water Main Replacement Program, without increasing the aggregate appropriation or debt authorization for said purposes, by amendment of the Prior Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the BOROUGH COUNCIL of the BOROUGH OF KEANSBURG, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Section 3(a) of the Prior Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which the obligations are to be issued consist of the design and replacement of Well #5 and the Seabreeze Way Water Main Replacement Program, together with all work and materials necessary therefor or incidental thereto, as more fully described in plans and specifications on file with the Borough Clerk, as finally approved by the governing body of the Borough.

Section Two. The aggregate appropriation of \$895,000, the aggregate debt authorization of \$850,250, the useful life of twenty (20) years, and other authorizations of the Prior Ordinance remain unchanged and are hereby confirmed.

Section Three. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in such conflict or are inconsistent. In the event that any section, part or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part hereof other than the part so held unconstitutional or invalid.



Section Four. This amendatory bond ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage, as provided in the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-1 et seq.
